Greetings from SAFF.

Upon a written request from our Member Association of Nepal supported by our Member Associations of Bangladesh, Bhutan, and Sri Lanka requesting the amendment of the current SAFF Statutes, SAFF will convene a SAFF Extraordinary Congress 2025 on 4 April 2025 in Colombo, Sri Lanka, at which the following Agendas will be transacted.

1. Roll Call;
2. Discussion and approval of the proposed amendment of the SAFF Statutes;
3. Miscellaneous (if any) with the permission of the Chair.

In accordance with Articles 20.1 and 20.2 of the SAFF Statutes, each Member Association shall have one (1) vote and is entitled to be represented by a maximum of two (2) delegates to participate in the SAFF Extraordinary Congress 2025, among them, one (1) shall exercise the right to vote on behalf of the Member Association. The names of the delegates must reach the SAFF General Secretariat by no later than 23:59 hours (Bangladesh time) on 17 March 2025 indicating the delegate authorised to vote.

The SAFF will provide you with further details relating to accommodation, transport, official functions, visa requirements, and travel arrangements for the SAFF Extraordinary Congress 2025 in due course.
